1. Obligor shall actively and diligently seek employment including, but not limited to:
 - A. Reporting to the Illinois Department of Employment Security (250 N. Chicago St., Joliet, IL or 321 Quadrangle Dr., Bolingbrook, IL) once a week and following up on all leads;
 - B. Applying to at least ten (10) new places each week for jobs which obligor can perform;
 - C. Keeping a list of places and dates where applications have been filed, verified in writing by a representative of the prospective employer or by other written documentation.
 - D. Not refusing any job which obligor is physically able to do, even if the job is not in his/her chosen trade or occupation, or is not full-time or pays less than the pay obligor is used to earning, or is temporary.
2. Yes No Obligor shall report on _____, 20__ at 1:00 p.m., to the Workforce Services Division of Will located at 1115 Plainfield Road, Joliet, IL 60435 and shall comply with all rules and recommendations of the Workforce Services Division staff, until further order of the court.
3. Upon procurement of employment, obligor shall notify support recipient or their counsel within _____ days of the employer's name, address, telephone number and salary.
4. Visitation problems and questions relating to custody are no excuse for non-payment. If visitation problems arise, the parent must petition the Court to settle the problem, but support must be paid until the Court orders differently.
